Intelligences	• In the first session, we will examine Gardner's theory of Multiple Intelligences and develop a better understanding of the eight intelligences. We will learn about our own intelligences and discuss approaches to applying MI theory in our classrooms and programs.
	• In the second session, we will discuss issues of implementing MI theory in adult education. We will strategize about how to decrease barriers and increase supports for incorporating MI-inspired instruction into specific classroom contexts, and we will reflect on the promises and challenges involved.
	• In the final session, we will discuss common features of MI-informed practice that emerged from the AMI study. We will develop next steps adult educators could take for applying MI to their own work.
